



Owned by the Hambro family, like nearby Wiltons, Franco's has been in business for more than half a century. Until a couple of years ago it was just a café with a few pavement tables, but the café now leads through to a proper restaurant. The understated dining room is strangely reminiscent of Harry's bar in Venice and there are also more than a few similarities as far as the menu goes. There is carpaccio, some lovely risottos (try the wild asparagus in spring) and liver Veneziana – all of it very good. There is also a private dining room in the basement that's worth remembering for holding small parties. £££
