Verdicchio

Verdicchio is a white wine grape variety that has been cultivated for hundreds of years in the Marche region of central Italy. It is a versatile variety, used both for light, easy-drinking table wines, and for more complex, ageworthy examples. The binding characteristic across these styles is the telltale almond flavor, which can be accompanied by bitter notes when young or a rich, sweet suggestion of marzipan and honey as the wine ages.

Barbaresco

Barolo is actually the fruitiest and most full-bodied of all the Nebbiolo regions in Northern Italy. When drinking it, expect flavors of raspberry, red cherry, roses, allspice and truffles. The lighter-tasting wine communes include La Morra and Barolo, while the bolder-tasting wine communes include Serralunga d'Alba, Monforte d'Alba, and Castiglione Falletto, The wine's high acidity is perfect to match against higher acid foods with saltiness, fat or olive oil to compliment the wine's tannin.

Chianti

Castello Di Monsanto

The family rejected shortcuts, commercially driven compromises on quality which would have required the vines to be planted densely, large concentrations of vines and the use of chemicals.

They refused to embrace trends that had erased the identity of entire regions, companies and their wines. Castello di Monsanto has followed this strategy ever since its creation – and these are the decisions that have made it what it is today, despite them meaning having to take a harder path.

Wines are made with 100% special clone of Sangiovese, called Brunello or Prugnolo Gentile.

Due to its thicker-skinned berries, Brunello produces wines with exceptionally bold fruit flavors, high tannin, and high acidity. Brunello, with its savory punch and brilliant acidity make it a fair contender with richly flavored red meats, tomato-based dishes and Tuscan-inspired fare that highlights olive oil and vinegar.

Amarone della Valpolicella

Amarone della Valpolicella is a wine made with partially dried grapes in Valpolicella, Veneto, north-east Italy. Amarone from Classico tends to be the most elegant and aromatic, while versions from the Valpantena are generally lighter and fruitier. The most common aromas are cherry liqueur, black fig, carob, cinnamon, and plum sauce along with subtle notes of green peppercorn, chocolate. On the palate, Amarone wines often have medium-plus to high acidity balanced with high alcohol.

Sassicaia

Sassicaia is normally about 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 14% Cabernet Franc. It is made in a simple fashion way, fermented in stainless-steel, temperature-controlled vats and then aged for up to 24 months in two-thirds new French oak barrels.

The winemaking process has been pretty much the same since the Incisa della Rocchetta family started using stainless steel vats in the early 1980s.
